Surveyors, contractors, trades and anyone in the industry. Send a homeowner who appoints FADP, and we pay you a written commission on our professional fee for that job.

WHO IT IS FOR

Surveyors, contractors, builders, trades, estate agents – anyone who sits next to a homeowner who needs drawings or a planning pack. London first. Manchester and Birmingham the same way.

THE RATE, PLAINLY

A commission on FADP's professional fee – the number in our appointment letter, not a percentage of build cost. Written in a one-page introducer letter before we take the meeting. Paid when the client pays us for that stage.

Not a percentage of build cost. The figure is in the letter before the first meeting.

HOW IT WORKS

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| 01 | Email the name, the address, and that you are introducing them. | 02 | We send the introducer letter. You sign it. Then we take the meeting. |
| 03 | If they appoint us, you earn the commission written in the letter. | 04 | We pay you when the client pays us for that stage. |

THE RULES

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| ■ The client can know. We will say an introducer is involved. | ■ First signed letter wins if two people send the same lead. |
| ■ No appointment, no commission. | ■ No commission on work they already had with us. |
| ■ You cannot introduce your own job and collect the fee. | ■ No signed letter before the meeting means the lead is not counted. |
